2nd FEI Equestrian Sports Educative Event (ESEE) to return to Kenya from 31st of May to 3rd of June

NAIROBI, KENYA 29th May 2018 — The Horse association of Kenya (HAK) will be hosting the FEI Dressage Equestrian Sports Educative Event (ESEE) for the second time in two years. This 4 day workshop, which will be from the 31st of May to 3rd of June, will be held at Purdy Arms conference facility in Karen with the afternoon practical sessions taking place at Karen Riding school. ESEE is a tool that the FEI (Fédération Équestre International) has set up to educate National Federation Officials. This is in the form of a workshop delivered by two technical experts – one FEI dressage judge and one Coach Educator.

Both will train dressage judges and coaches in theoretical sessions and through demonstration Athletes in practical sessions. The fourth day will see a mini competition in the morning at Karen Riding School, where the participants will demonstrate their skills as dressage judges and as coaches while the demonstration Athletes ride their practiced dressage tests.
